Historic Hastings Car Shows Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: What is the Cost of Admission?
 - A: Admission cost is free
- Q: How old does my vehicle have to be for admittance to the show area?
 - A: 1985 or earlier
- Q: Are motorcycles allowed in the show area?
 - A: This show is limited to classic cars & trucks (4 wheeled vehicles)
- Q: Where do I park?
 - A: Show parking is **1st come 1st served** within the car show boundaries
 - A: There are only a few spots reserved for sponsors.
 - A: Spectators may utilize one of many lots outside of the show area
 - i) Depot Park Parking lot on Tyler Street.
 - ii) City public lot on 4th Street
 - iii) Public parking lot under HWY 61 Bridge
 - iv) Public ramp on 2nd Street
- Q: Where do I go if I want to display my car?
 - A: All cars show cars will need to enter 2nd Street at Tyler St & 2nd Street. Volunteers will be there to show you to an open spot.
- Q: What time does the show start?
 - A: Gates open at 10 a.m. for cars displaying in the show.
 - A: Gates open to the public at 11 a.m. and the show ends at 4 p.m.
- O: Do I have to leave at 4:00?
 - A: You are welcome to stay in town and enjoy our local shops, restaurant and many other attractions Hastings has to offer. We ask that you move your car if you don't plan on shopping or dining.
- Q: Will there be food and beverages available for purchase?
 - A: Yes, there will be several choices available within the car show boundaries including our local restaurants as well as few food trucks.
- Q: Will local traffic laws and ordinances be enforced?
 - A: **Absolutely** you must always obey all traffic laws and city ordinances
